After reading the enclosed materials please call our office for a test day or interview appointment. All incoming students (grades 2nd through 12th) must take an entrance examination and have an interview. - 6th through 12th grade students must have 3 reference forms completed/*Estudiantes de 6 – 12 grado tienen que entregar 3 referencias.*
- These materials plus a \$75 testing fee must be presented before the test is administered/*Estos documentos más un el cardo de \$75 por el examen de entrada tienen que ser entregado el día de su cita.*

Following the examination the school will notify you by mail whether or not you may proceed with registration. Results of the entrance exam will be made available to parents of students who are accepted as students at La Progresiva Presbyterian School. *Después de la prueba la escuela le notificara a usted por correo si usted puede o no proceder con la registraci3n.
